Dr. George T. Chiampas is a Clinical Instructor and Attending Physician in Emergency Medicine at Northwestern University and the Feinberg School of Medicine, as well as consulting physician for the U.S. Soccer National Team and medical director for several athletic events in the Chicago area.

After receiving his Bachelors of Science degree from Chicago's Loyola University, Dr. Chiampas completed his residency in Emergency Medicine at Cook County Hospital where he was named Trauma Resident of the Class of 2003. He went on to serve as Attending Physican of Emergency Medicine at Rush University Medical Center and completed his Primary Care Sports Medicine Fellowship at Resurrection Medical Center. In addition, Dr. Chiampas completed his internship at Illinois Masonic Medical Center and received his Doctorate of Osteopathy from Midwestern University.

Since completing his training, Dr. Chiampas has been an active instructor of Emergency Medicine and Sports Medicine to medical students, residents and Sports Medicine Fellows. He has served as team physician for Loyola Academy and North Park University and has traveled internationally with the U.S. Soccer Team. Dr. Chiampas served as a consulting physician for the Chicago Marathon from 2000 to 2006, and was named Medical Director of the Bank of America Chicago Marathon and Shamrock Shuffle 8K in 2007.
